# **Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference**



One of the top football conferences in the nation, the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) has sent at least two teams to the NCAA Tournament each of the past six seasons, including the defending national champion Grand Valley State, which has won three of the last four titles.

All that in just seven years as the GLIAC returned to sponsor play on the gridiron in 1999 after ten years without football. For the previous nine seasons, the football playing schools of the GLIAC had been members of the Midwest Intercollegiate Football Conference (MIFC). The MIFC was formed in 1990 as a merger between the football playing schools of the GLIAC and the five football members of the Heartland Collegiate

Conference. The MIFC was also a premier conference in NCAA Division II football, sending 11 teams to the national playoffs over the nine year period.

Since its founding in 1972, the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) has been a leader in the advancement and promotion of intercollegiate athletics for men and women. The charter members of the GLIAC were Grand Valley State University, Lake Superior State University, Northwood University, and Saginaw Valley State University.

Overall, the GLIAC conducts championships in 19 sports, nine for men and 10 for women. The policy-making body of the GLIAC is the Executive Council, which is comprised of three representatives from each
